## Senior League Rules

1. The Leagues are open to all Clubs who are members of Tennis Tayside.
  2. Players eligible to represent a Club in the League Competition must be a fully paid up member of such Club as defined in their rules. Players may only play for one Club in a season in one competition. However, players may play for different Clubs in different competitions, provided that they are fully paid up members of these Clubs.
  3. The Clubs competing in each division will be determined annually by Tennis Tayside, under predetermined conditions. League Secretaries will at the same time decide on all details of the competition, ie start date, size and number of divisions, Rule changes, etc..
  4. For the purposes of determining the Leagues to be held and their participants, the Clubs entering will be put, as far as possible, into equal divisions. On the completion of the season's Leagues generally the top two teams in the division will be promoted and the bottom two teams relegated, (this may be varied depending on the numbers in each division).
  5. All matches will be played under the 'Rules of the Lawn Tennis Association' and the 'Regulations for the Management of the Lawn Tennis Tournaments' as adopted by Tennis Scotland. The Scottish Cup Rules are as laid down in the Tennis Scotland Handbook.
- ### Teams
6. Each competing team will have a nominated Captain who will be responsible for the regulations of play during a match. Any disputes arising will be settled in the first place by the team Captains. In the event of an unresolved dispute the League Secretary should be consulted, whose decision will be final.
  7. Each competing team will usually consist of six players who will be arranged into pairs by their respective Captains.
  8. Clubs must play their best three available couples in their first team, their next best three couples in their second team, etc.. If teams do not comply it may result in the offending team/s losing the sets affected by the non-compliance. (The spirit of this rule means that if a club team in a higher league has a match cancelled, or is not playing on a normally scheduled night, they do not play instead of the normal members of the lower team.)

9. Complaints regarding the composition of teams must be made in writing or via email to the League Secretary within 72 hours of the event.
10. Draw :
  - a) In 3 court matches each pair will play two sets against each pair of the opposing team, according to the draw. (18 sets in total)
  - b) In 2 court matches two sets are played against the opposite number and one set against each of the other two, according to the draw. (12 sets in total)

Each set will be a tie-breaking set with the tie-break operating if the score reaches six all.

11. A fixed sequence of play will operate with the draw at the beginning merely deciding in which order the sequence will be played. The sequence is as follows:

#### Timings:

12. *Before the draw either Captain may request a finishing time for the match, this request must be granted. The following rules apply:*

- a) *The earliest finish time is 9.30pm, light permitting.*
- b) *A minimum of two rounds must be completed. (If this is not done within the time limit then both captains may agree to continue play until the second round is completed, or one team may concede the required games)*
- c) *Whilst only completed sets will be counted towards the match score, all games played should be entered on the score sheet as they will be included in any countback should there be a draw in points and sets at the end of the season.*

#### Single Point Deuce Option:

These may be adopted **where both teams, or couples, agree**. They can operate throughout the match for all couples, for one or two couples only, and for all, one or two of the rounds. The key is that couples should agree. In the case of deuce the receivers can indicate who will receive. Please note on the scoresheet where this mechanism is used.

13. **Matches start at 18.15pm prompt.** Any couples not on court and ready to play (with or without a knock up) by 18.30pm will forfeit the first round. Similarly, any couple not available and ready for play within ten minutes of the completion of round one will forfeit their remaining sets.
14. Where a team has to travel more than 15 miles the away Captain has the right to request a start time of 18.45pm. this request must be made at least 48 hours prior to the match and must be granted.

#### Points & Results:

15. In League matches a ½ point is awarded for a winning set. At the conclusion of a match the team with the highest number of points is the winning team. If the sets are equal the match is a draw. Teams gain two points for winning and one point for a draw.
16. The League positions will be determined primarily by points.
  - a) Where two or more teams are level on points then the percentage of total sets won over total sets played will determine which team comes top.
  - b) If this is still equal then percentage of games won over games played will count. If this still results in two teams being equal then the matches between the tied teams will become the decider - firstly by points, then sets and finally games.
17. In the event of any Club failing to fulfil their obligation to play a match on the set date or one mutually arranged or ordered by the League Secretary and no reasonable explanation is forthcoming then that Club will be judged to have forfeited the match and the points. As a penalty the forfeiting Club will have a point deducted from their total points for each match not played.
18. In the case of conceded matches **both teams** must still process the score

sheet in the usual manner or email the notification to the League Secretary. Teams receiving a concession will be credited with the 2 points for winning and with their average sets and games scores which will be calculated at the end of the League.

19. The match score sheet detailing the names of all the players and their scores will be signed by both Captains and forwarded by the winning team to the League Secretary within 72 hours of the match being completed. Winning teams who fail to comply with this will not have the points added to their total. **Missing score sheets will not be chased.**
20. Signed score sheets can be sent by post or scanned and emailed to the relevant League Secretary.

### **Match Nights & Continuations:**

21. Normal and continuations:

**Ladies** matches will normally be played on a **Monday** evening. If postponed or uncompleted through adverse weather or court conditions matches will be played or continued on the **Wednesday** of that week, providing neither team are already scheduled for a match on that date.

**Men's** matches will be played on a **Thursday** evening. If postponed or uncompleted through adverse weather or court conditions will be played or continued on the following **Tuesday**.

**Henderson Vase** matches are to be played on **Monday** evenings and if postponed or uncompleted will continue on the **Tuesday** evening following. However, if there are clubs without lights or who wish to change the night of the match to a weekend afternoon that would be acceptable. Such a re-arrangement should be agreed between the two captains at a reasonable time before the match is to be played. Such a re-arranged match can be played on the weekend before or after the Monday date given in the Handbook. The League Secretary does not have to be told in advance.

In all cases if, on continuation, the match is still not completed the Captains should agree mutually on a continuation date and this must be communicated to the League Secretary immediately. However, if the captains cannot agree the League Secretary will fix a date for the match to be completed.

22. Unfavourable weather and/or unplayable court conditions are deemed as satisfactory reasons for not playing. In case of any doubt the captain of the

home team should contact their opponents as soon as is practicable with details of the conditions and likelihood of play.

23. As an alternative to rearranging, provided that at least two rounds have been completed and that both the Captains agree, the match result can be decided by completed, divided or conceded sets. *(Please note that these conceded / divided sets will not be included in any countback if there is a draw in points.)* If no agreement is reached a continuation should be arranged.
24. Continuations:
  - a) No change may be made to the composition of teams after start of play. However, where a match is unfinished and has to be continued on another day agreed substitutes may replace unavailable players.
  - b) The match will resume at the point of interruption.
25. Any Club intending to concede a match without commencing a match must inform both the Captain of the opposing club and the League Secretary before the time agreed upon for playing.
26. Responsibility for the provision of nets, balls, teas, etc., rests with the host Club. The exception will be if the match is played at a third party Club when it will be the responsibility of the Club on whose ground the match should have been played, or if the venue is reversed by mutual agreement..
27. Any team withdrawing from any League or conceding more than two matches will be relegated down two divisions the following season
28. The Tennis Tayside Board will have the power to alter or add to the above rules as they may deem appropriate. All questions of eligibility, qualifications or interpretation of the rules will be referred initially to the League Secretaries and then to the Board whose decision will be final.

## Junior League Rules

1. The teams shall consist of 4 players, either boys, girls or mixed, who shall all be under 16 years of age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year. (i.e. born 1994 or later).
2. Where a Club enters more than one team it must play the best 4 available players in the 1<sup>st</sup> team, the next best 4 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> team and so on for the 3<sup>rd</sup>s and 4<sup>th</sup>s. A Club's 1<sup>st</sup> team must be filled before their 2<sup>nd</sup> team i.e. the 1<sup>st</sup> team cannot concede a match on the grounds of not having a team if the Club's 2<sup>nd</sup> team is full.
3. Players eligible to represent a club in the League Competition must be a fully paid up member of such club as defined in their rules. Players may only play for one club in a season in one competition. However, players may play for different clubs in different competitions, eg the Senior Leagues, provided that they are fully paid up members of these clubs.
4. Each team **MUST** be accompanied by a responsible adult, aged 17 or over, who is to act as non- playing captain. They must be present for the duration of the match and **both adults must sign the score sheet**. Points will be deducted for continual disregard of this rule.
5. The standard match time is Saturday at 3pm. It is permissible to alter match times if both teams are agreeable. It will be necessary to change home match times for some clubs who have entered multiple teams. Requests to change match times should be made no later than Monday of the match week.
6. If a match requires to be rearranged for any reason, it should be played on the earliest mutually agreeable date and in any case must be completed within **two weeks** beyond the last scheduled match date in the appropriate division. Failure to do so will result in the match being declared void. **The Junior League Secretary is to be notified immediately after any postponement takes place.**
7. The HOME team is responsible for providing good quality balls - a minimum of 3 per court - and providing teas.
8. Each match will consist of 4 singles rubbers and two doubles rubbers. Generally, a tie-break will operate in each set at 6 all. Each singles rubber will consist of 3 sets, where the deciding third set is a match tie break (first to ten points with two point margin). Doubles rubbers are only two sets.

9. A team must play in order of merit - ie best player at No1, second best at No 2 - for the singles. For the Doubles the No1 player must partner the No 2 and the No 3 must partner the No 4.
10. Playing order for a normal match:

- **All singles rubbers are best of three sets where the deciding set is a match tie break**
- **Doubles rubbers are two sets**
- **The Home Club decides which round is played first**

11. The scoring systems is as follows:

- Normally each set is worth one point. Thus there are twelve points to be won from sets. If a singles match goes to a deciding third set then the winning player receives 1.33 points and the loser 0.67 points.
- A bonus of two points is gained for winning the most sets.
- If sets are equal then the games won will determine who wins the game. If games are equal then each team gets one bonus point.
- One point is awarded for each player who plays (ie four points for a full team).
- At the end of the match between two full teams the score should add up to 22, (eg 13 – 9, or 16 – 6).

12. The following changes to the Rules are made to accommodate two court clubs when playing at home.

- The singles rubbers are to be ONE SET ONLY.
- Playing order for the 2 court match :-

- **Singles rubbers are one set only – doubles rubbers are two sets**
- **The Home club decides whether Round 1 or Round 2 is played first**
- **Round 3 must be played last**

- Each set is worth 1.5 points instead of 1 point. Thus 12 points are available as in 3 court matches.

13. League positions are determined by points won.

14. Normally, the top two teams in each league will be promoted and the bottom two teams will be relegated for the following season. This may be altered if there is any change in the number of entrants for the following season.

15. The non-playing captains of BOTH TEAMS are responsible for sending the completed score sheet duly signed by both non-playing captains to reach the Junior League Secretary by second post on the Thursday following the match. Results not received by this date will be declared void. Please write the name of the team sending in the sheet at the top of the score sheet. **Players' year of birth should be added to score sheets beside their name.**

17. Results must be completed on the official Tennis Tayside Match Score Sheets, still titled MDSLTA, with all parts fully completed and signed.

18. In the case of conceded matches **both Teams** must still process the score sheet in the usual manner. Teams receiving a concession will be credited with their average points score, which will be determined by the League Secretary at the end of the League programme. Teams conceding a match will receive zero points.

19. All disputes should be referred to the Junior League Secretary in writing within 72 hours of the disputed event.
